



HUMANITIES - HISTORY

Historically significant Individuals and Events - Harriet Tubman and the Underground Railroad

Look at evidence to give and explain reasons why people in the past may have acted in the way they did. Show understanding of some of the ways in which we find out about the past and identify different ways in which it is represented.



ENGLISH

Key texts: Before She Was Harriet by Lesa Cline-Ransome, Harriet Tubman by Isable Sanchez Vegara

Outcomes: Poetry, Persuasive Letter, Narrative



MATHS

Measurement and money - cementing adding & subtraction skills: Recognise coins and notes. Count money in pounds and pence. Compare money including finding the same amount. Add and subtract 2-digit and 1-digit calculations within the context of money.

Multiplication & Division: Understand multiplication as representing equal groups. Use arrays to represent multiplication as repeated addition.

Times tables: groups of 2 and commutativity, groups of 10 and of 5, and factors of 0 or 1. Look at the link between 5 and 10 times tables as doubles.

Understand doubling and halving. Odd and even numbers - explicit links to doubling and 2 times table. Division of 2, 5 and 10 through grouping. Division using 'grouping' and 'sharing'. Division by using known times table facts and halving. Dividing by zero and one.

SCIENCE

Plants - Observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. Find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.



COMPUTING - Programming - Robot Algorithms

Use logical reasoning to predict the outcome of a program (series of commands), design an algorithm, create and debug a program that the children have written.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION: SPEED, JUMP, THROW Master running, jumping and throwing, as well as developing balance, agility and coordination.

PLAY, WIN, LOSE Master running, agility, balance and coordination. Engage in competitive and cooperative activities.

RE

Concept – remembering. Unit of Work: Passover, celebration to remember God helped the Jews. (Judaism)

PSHE - Personal Social Health Economic: Relationships Education: to understand life in different countries. Online Safety: what personal information is and who to trust online. Mental Wellbeing: To recognise and describe different feelings in themselves and others.

ART & DESIGN and DESIGN TECHNOLOGY:

MUSIC: Singing Skills - Feel the Pulse - learning songs with a focus on accurate singing, rhythm and pulse.
