HUMANITIES - GEOGRAPHY and HISTORY

NW5 - Local Area and London Geographical and Historical Study - Create a Guided Tour of NW5. Compare and contrast ordnance survey maps, What is NW5? Understand the concept of 'Identity' of a place, conduct an enquiry into the local area, survey and map human and physical features of the local area.

ENGLISH

Key texts: The Lost Words by Robert McFarlane, Your Wellbeing Garden by RHS, A Stage Full of Shakespeare Stories - Macbeth

Outcomes: Nature Poetry, Community Garden Proposal, Shakespeare letters / speeches.



MATHS

Decimals - Decimals up to 2 decimal places, Understand thousandths, Three decimal places, Multiply by 10, 100 and 1,000. Divide by 10, 100 and 1,000, Multiply decimals by integers, Divide decimals by integers, Division to solve problems. Percentages - Percentage equivalents for fractions and decimals, percentages of amounts, percentage problem solving. Measurement, Perimeter, Area and Volume - Convert between units, formula for perimeter, area and volume, context measurement problems.

SCIENCE

Living things and their habitats. Describe how living things are classified into broad groups according to common observable characteristics and based on similarities and differences, including microorganisms, plants and animals. Give reasons for classifying plants and animals based on specific characteristics.



COMPUTING

Programming A – Variables in games. Choose how to improve a game by using variables, use a design to create a project, evaluate my project.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

SCORE, STEAL, SUPPORT - Develop technique and control. Play competitive games, modified where appropriate. Apply basic principles suitable for attacking and defending. PRACTISE, PRESENT, FEEDBACK - Gymnastics coach. Develop a broader range of skills and link them to make sequences of movement. Develop flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance. Compare their performances with previous ones and demonstrate improvement to achieve their personal best.
