

HUMANITIES - GEOGRAPHY


Geographical Skills and Knowledge Study: Tectonic. Understand the processes that give rise to key physical and human geographical features of the world - how mountains are formed, how earthquakes and volcanoes occur. Case studies of earthquakes and eruptions over time. Study different topographical features - magma chamber, vents, craters and slopes. Understand the impact of earthquakes and volcanoes on how humans live - human geography.



ENGLISH

Key texts: World Book Day - The Midnight Fair by Gideon Sterer, World Speech Day, Pop Up Volcano by Fleur Daugey (non-fiction) Earth Shattering Events by Sophie Williams (non fiction).

Outcomes: volcano information text (to inform), volcanic eruption news report (to report)



MATHS

Fractions: Understanding parts and wholes. Represent unit and non-unit fractions and use them as numbers. Count up and down in tenths. Compare and order unit and non-unit fractions. Find a fraction of a set of objects. Add and subtract fractions within one whole. Solve problems using fractions. Understanding parts and wholes.

Measurement: Mass and Capacity Measure and compare mass. Used mixed units when dealing with mass. Add and subtract mass. Solve problems involving mass. Measure and compare capacity and volume. Use mixed units when dealing with capacity and volume. Add and subtract volume. Solve problems involving capacity and volume.

SCIENCE

Rocks - Compare and group together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties. Describe how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within rocks. Recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.

COMPUTING - Data and information - Branching Databases. Creating branching databases, identify objects using branching databases, compare them to pictograms.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION: Run, Jump, Throw - Using running, jumping and throwing in isolation and combination. Develop flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance. Mission, Challenge, Teamwork - Enjoy communicating, collaborating and competing with each other. Take part in outdoor and adventurous activity challenges both individually and within a team. Balance, Choose, Link- Develop a broader range of skills and link them to make sequences of movement. Develop flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance. Understand how to improve and learn how to evaluate.
