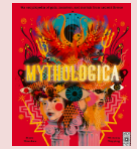
## HUMANITIES - HISTORY and GEOGRAPHY Ancient Greece

What is the legacy of the Ancient Greeks? Studying the geography of Greece and the daily lives of the people including Ancient Greek values and achievements, with particular emphasis on democracy, language, sport, architecture and rhetoric. Which is the most important legacy of the Ancient Greeks?

### ENGLISH

Key texts: Mythologica by Stever Kershaw and Victoria Topping, The Odyssey by Gillian Cross, Myths, Monsters and Mayhem by James Davies & Greek Myths by Geraldine McCaughrean

Outcomes: Character Fact File (to inform), Fictional narrative (to entertain), Greek Myth Recount (to recount and to entertain).



### MATHS

Mastering Number: automaticity of multiplication tables and application of multiplication and division facts.

Review of column addition & subtraction: adding and subtracting a pair of 2-digit numbers with and without regrouping, using known facts and efficient strategies to calculate and check column addition and subtraction, evaluate the efficiency of strategies for addition and subtraction.

Numbers to 10,000: composition of numbers to 1,000, common conversions using knowledge of 1,000, decomposing 4-digit numbers, comparing and ordering 4-digit numbers, rounding to the nearest hundred and ten, add up to three 4-digit numbers.

### SCIENCE

Animals including humans: Discover the role of the digestive system in the human body and identify the role of the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions for carnivores, omnivores and herbivores. Construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey.

COMPUTING: Computing systems and networks – The Internet. Describe how networks physically connect to other networks and how websites can be shared via the World Wide Web. Describe how content can be added and accessed online by people and evaluate the consequences of unreliable content.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION: ESCAPE, GUARD, HELP - Use running, jumping, throwing and catching. Play competitive games.

CHOOSE, LINK, PRESENT - Develop a broader range of skills...and link them to make sequences of movement. Develop flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance. Understand how to improve and learn how to evaluate and recognise their own success.

RE Concept – Symbol Unit Of Work- Trees - Cross Faith.

PSHE - Personal Social Health Economic:

Living in the Wider World: Class charters and goal setting, the rights of a child. Black History Season- equality, challenging racism. Health and Wellbeing: food and nutrients. Drugs Education: Asthma and the medicines used to treat it, the effects and risks of alcohol and behaviours related to drug use.

ART & DESIGN and DESIGN TECHNOLOGY:

Screen and mono printing - layering colours. Images inspired by Greek mythology, working with artist Kara Porter.

MUSIC: Ancient Greece - Compose a song based on this period of time. Write their own rhyming couplet lyrics based on events, compose and record the music and vocals.

FRENCH: Presenting Myself: Basic greetings and ask how someone is feeling. How to ask and answer the question what's your name?
